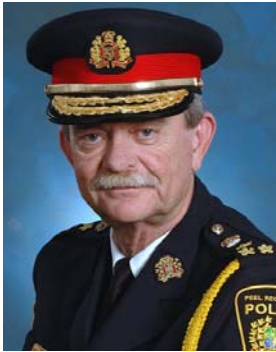

Mayor Hazel McCallion is a people's Mayor who was first elected Mayor of Mississauga in November, 1978, and is the longest serving Mayor in the City's history. She was acclaimed in 1980, re-elected in 1982 and 1985, acclaimed again in 1988 and re-elected in 1991, 1994, 1997, 2000, 2003 and 2006. Chief H. Mike Metcalf was appointed Chief of Peel Regional Police in January, 2006, after 34 years of distinguished service.

Leading the third largest municipal police service in Canada, with **1,800** uniformed members and **760** civilian support staff. Peel Regional Police provides policing services for the cities of Brampton and Mississauga, a total population of 1,200,000. Service is also provided to Lester B. Pearson International Airport, which has an annual transient population of 29,000,000 travelers.

During his 39 years of policing, Chief Metcalf has been assigned to a number of areas spanning our organization. During that time, he was instrumental in the development of the Automated Fingerprint Identification System, the Automated Mug shot Retrieval System and the implementation of all aspects of the Ontario Adequacy Regulations for policing.

Chief Metcalf is a member of the International, Canadian and Ontario Chiefs of Police Associations. He has completed a number of police management and executive training courses at both the Ontario and Canadian Police Colleges, including the Senior Police Administration course and the Executive Development course. He is also a past instructor at Sheridan College in the area of Criminalistics. Chief Metcalf's awards include the Thirty-Year Exemplary Service Medal, the Queen's Gold Jubilee Medal and the Francis Xavier Fernandes Memorial Award, which recognizes outstanding achievement in the field of criminal identification.

Chief Metcalf has long lead the cause for volunteerism and community service. He has served as the Honourary Chair of both the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation and the Children's Breakfast Club. He has also strengthened organizational commitment to community-based fundraising, including; The United Way, Cops for Cancer, Special Olympics and Big Brothers Big Sisters.



Bonnie Crombie MP Streetsville; Bonnie was elected to Parliament in the 2008 general election on October 28 and proudly represents the riding of Mississauga - Streetsville. She is committed to earning and keeping the trust of her constituents.
